## Chapter 2 Post-lesson Town Way

**PIER** – a platform extending from a shore over water and supported by piles or pillars, used to secure, protect, and provide access to ships or boats.

**ROWBOAT** – a small shallow boat fitted with wooden crosspieces used as a seat and rowlocks for oars to propel it forward.
