

Know all men by these presents that I, Abner B. Gifford of Westport, in the County of Bristol, Esquire, in consideration of one Dollar, to me paid by the Inhabitants of Westport, aforesaid, the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge, do hereby lease, demise and let unto the said Inhabitants of Westport, so much of a tract of land situate in said Westport (where the Powder-house now stands, which was erected by said Inhabitants) as is necessary & convenient for the use of said Powder-house, so long as said Inhabitants shall occupy the same for a Powder-house and no longer - To have and to hold said leased premises with the privileges aforesaid during the time aforesaid, to the said Inhabitants of Westport: In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fourth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & twenty one.
