The Cadman-White-Handy House is in the <u>Georgian</u> style of <u>architecture,</u> which was very popular in the 1700s when it was built. This style was named after King George of England.

It is based on balance; also called <u>symmetry</u>. Symmetry is when certain parts of something look the same on either side of its middle. Basically, if you cut something in half, it will be the same on each side.
