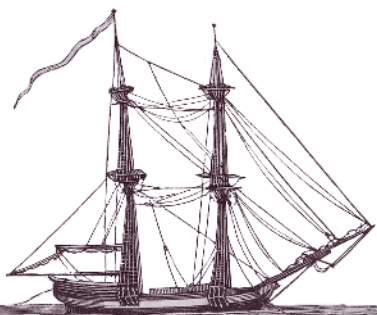


FAMILY ENTERPRISES AND THE IMPORTANCE OF THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN PAUL CUFFE AND MICHAEL WAINER

Ships Built and Owned by Paul Cuffe and often Michael Wainer



1.
1778-9. Built small sailing boat with brother David, possibly a shallop.
2.
1784. Trading on a 12-ton schooner bought with brother-in-law, Michael Wainer.
3.
1787 Built **“Sunfish,”** 25-ton Schooner, Cuffe and Wainer as owners.
4.
1792. Built **“Mary,”** 42-ton Schooner, Cuffe and Wainer as owners.
5.
1795. Built **“Ranger,”** 62-ft, square-sterned Schooner; sold **“Mary”** and **“Sunfish”**.
6.
1801. Built **“Hero,”** 162-ton brig, owned with Isaac Cory (Sr. and Jr.) Cuffe had 1/4 interest.
7.
1806. Built **“Alpha,”** 268-ton ship, Cuffe had 3/4 interest and Lemuel Milk 1/4 interest.



8.
1807. Built **“Traveller,”** 109-ton brig, Cuffe and Milk as owners.

Peter Howard

Naomi Cuffe married Peter Howard (c.1785-1814) in 1806. Shipbuilder and business partner to Paul Cuffe.

Captain Alvan Phelps

Mary Cuffe married Captain Alvan Phelps (1783-1831) in 1806.

Alexander Howard

Ruth Cuffe married Alexander Howard (c.1785-1821) in 1806. Shipbuilder and business partner to Paul Cuffe.

Captain John Mastin

Mary Wainer married Captain John Mastin (1782-1860) in 1809.

Captain Pardon Cook

Alice Cuffe married Captain Pardon Cook (1796-1849) in 1820.
